Casey Marlow, Glenelg Libraries Children's and Youth Services Officer, will support Magic of Storytime by reading an additional book and providing a fun activity for the children to complete.

CEO Magic of Storytime will take place on the first Friday of every month (except School holidays) from 11.00am at Glenelg Libraries Bentinck Street, Portland. A partnership with United Way Glenelg, Portland Aluminium and Glenelg Libraries it supports the Dolly Parton Imagination Library.
