"For the past week, we have been desperately looking for the GREEN SHEEP, spending Wednesday putting up flyers all over business windows," said Ms Carr.

"The GREEN SHEEP is wooley and green in colour. We are desperate to find him and hope to have him home soon,' concluded Ms Carr.

- Children scan the visibly identifiable QR codes located on the window near the business front entrance and will not be required to enter the shop or download the app to participate.
- The activity must be conducted with an adult as it will require children to zig-zag across the street.
- Children can receive their reward for finding the GREEN SHEEP at the front desk at Glenelg Library Portland.
